



## **IMPLEMENTATION OF ERP CAR PARK SYSTEM AT TANAH MERAH FERRY TERMINAL (TMFT)**

With effect from 3 August 2004, the current chip-coin car park system at TMFT will be converted to a ERP / Cash Card System. This is to improve service quality to passengers and create a smoother, flow-through experience for terminal users.

The new system operates in a similar fashion to the Electronic Road Pricing System which reads the In-Vehicle Unit (IU) Number of the vehicle and automatically records the length of stay of the vehicle in the car park. For non-season parking users, the charges will be automatically deducted from the Cash Card which is to be placed in the IU during exit. Cash Card top-up machines / multi-stations are located outside the TMFT Arrival Hall & at the Information Counter at the main concourse. In addition, Cash cards can also be topped up at the DBS & OCBC Automated Teller Machines (ATM) in the main concourse. Cash cards can also be purchased at multi-station outside the Arrival Hall.

Car park charges are as follows :

<b>Description</b>	<b>Rates</b>	<b>Remarks</b>
Hourly Parking	\$1 per hour or part thereof	Up to a max of \$6 between 0600 hrs and midnight
Day Parking	\$6 per day	0600 hrs to midnight
Night Parking	\$6 per night	Midnight to 0600 hrs

To facilitate passenger handling, taxis, buses and coaches will be allowed 1 hour free if they are waiting for passengers. Charges will be retrospective should the period of stay exceed 1 hour.
