



PACIFIC SKY MAKES HER INAUGURAL VOYAGE

The 46,087 GT Pacific Sky launched her Inaugural Service from Singapore on Saturday, 25 February 2006. She belongs to P & O Cruises (Australia), which is a subsidiary of Carnival Corporation (USA). Built in 1984, the ship can carry up to 1,200 passengers and she will be positioned in Singapore until early May 2006, when she will be transferred to her new Spanish owners, Pullmantur Cruises. During her tenure in Singapore, she will call and turn round passengers every consecutive Saturday, operating weekly cruises out of Singapore.
